What are ISNI and the PCC?

- **ISNI = International Standard Name Identifier**
 - Where? UK, France, Leiden
 - What? Entities: persons, corporate bodies
- **PCC = Program for Cooperative Cataloging**
 - Where? US, Canada, UK
 - What? Bibliographic records and entities, including persons, corporate bodies, families, bibliographic works, events, etc.
 - NACO (Name Authority Cooperative Program) authority records

PCC Pilot (background)

- Year-long pilot (July 2017-July 2018)
- Institutional participants (12) (including Harvard, Cornell, Stanford, UCLA, and others)
- Three PCC Standing Committees and a Task Group.
- Pilot Focus Areas:
 - Documentation & training
 - ISNI maintenance best practices
 - Workflow & tools best practices
 - Batch processing template/workflow
 - API review/testing

NACO versus ISNI (the basics)

NACO (authority control)

- Manages access to entities by authorizing a unique form of name for each entity
- Focus is on the string
- Designed for humans to disambiguate names
- Unique, authoritative text string represents an entity
- Attributes may be added to the string to make it unique

ISNI (identity management)

- Process of associating a registered identifier with a single entity
- Focus is on the identity
- Designed for computers to link to unique entities
- Unique number represents an entity
- Attributes define and describe the entity, for humans and for algorithms

NACO versus ISNI (input)

NACO

- Who: librarians; mostly in US and UK
- How:
 - Training program
 - Single record contributions
 - Quality control up front

ISNI

- Who: Libraries, property rights organizations, publishers, info aggregators; international
- How:
 - Training videos
 - Batch loads/Machine processes
 - Although manual input is possible as well
 - Quality control afterwards

NACO versus ISNI (provenance)

NACO

- “Usage” (literary warrant)
- Citations from publications and reference sources
 - Botticelli, Sandro, †d 1444 or 1445-1510
Horne, H.P. Botticelli, painter of Florence, 1980: †b t.p. (Botticelli) p. 1 (Alessandro Filipepi, commonly called Sandro Botticelli; Alessandro, son of M. Filipepi)

ISNI

- Contributing ISNI member (Source)
- Corroboration (>1 Source)
- Algorithm findings, programmed confidence levels

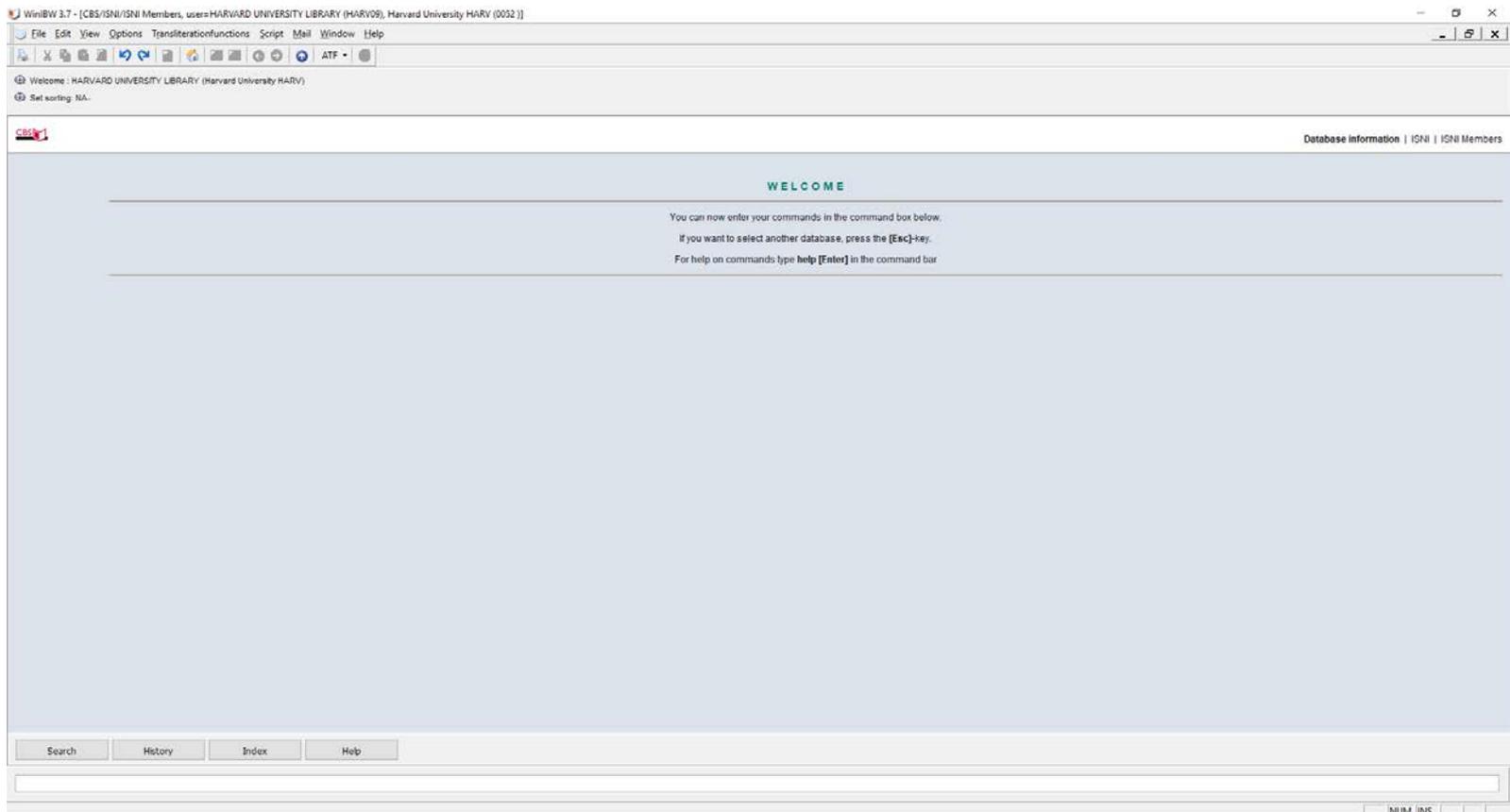

ISNI work on Kennedy project

- Lewis Branscomb
 - Emeritus professor; writes on science, technology, disaster resilience; PhD in physics in 1950

Lewis Branscomb is Public Service Professor of Public Policy and Corporate Management in the Aetna Chair Emeritus and former Chair of the Program on Science, Technology and Public Policy (1986 – 1996) in the Belfer Center in HKS. He is also Adjunct Professor at the University of California, San Diego and Distinguished Research Fellow in the Institute for Global Conflict and Cooperation of the University of California. A former Director of the National Bureau of Standards (1969 – 1972, now NIST) and Vice President and Chief Scientist of IBM (1972 – 1986), he served as Chairman of the National Science Board (1980 – 1984). A pioneer in negative ion photodetachment, he is author of books on science and technology policy, disaster resilience and counter terrorism, and early stage technology innovation. His AB in physics is from Duke University (*summa cum laude*, 1945) and physics PhD in 1950 from Harvard, where he was a Junior Fellow in the Society of Fellows.

Summary

- Authority work versus identity management
- Similar: differentiate, do not duplicate
- Difference: work in batches (although clean up manually); focus on machine consumption of data; no need for a unique name string

ISNI (what's to come?)

- Local authority files
- Data cleanup and enhancement
- Workflows for certain names?
 - Thesis authors
 - Thesis advisors
 - Names of clubs at the university
- ISNI PCC Training Task Group (chaired by John Hostage at Harvard)
