## How to reach KBR

### Public entrance

Mont des Arts 28, 1000 Brussels

### On foot

- From Brussels-Central Station – up to 5 minutes' walk (depends on which station exit you take)



### By public transport

#### Train

Stop at Brussels-Central Station - 5 minutes' walk to KBR.

You can plan your journey and buy tickets on [SNCB website](#) or download the [SNCB app](#).

- From Brussels Airport  
There's a train about every twelve minutes  
The train trip takes about 18 minutes to reach Brussels-Central Station
- From Brussels Midi Station  
There's a train about every five minutes  
The train trip takes about 5 minutes to reach Brussels-Central Station

## Underground, tram, bus

- Stopping at 'Place Royale'  
Tram lines: 92-93  
Bus lines: 33 – 38 – 71 – 95
- Stopping at 'Gare Centrale'  
Bus lines: 29 – 38 – 46 – 52 – 63 – 65 – 66 – 71  
Subway lines: 1 and 5

## By car

The underground pay-and-display parking 'Albertine' is located at Place de la Justice 16.  
Entrance via Place de la Justice or Rue des Sols.

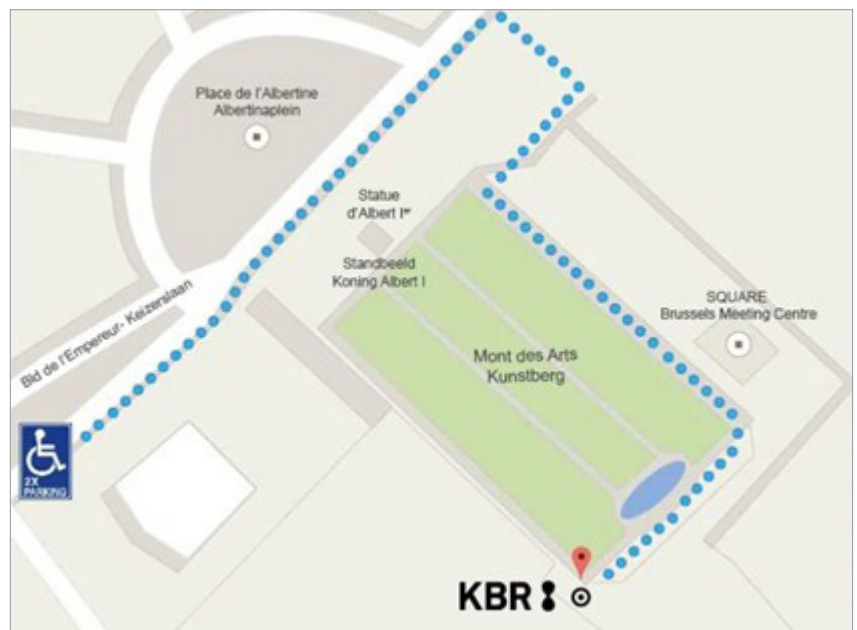
## Wheelchair accessibility

The building, the KBR museum and all reading rooms and reading rooms are wheelchair accessible.

## Parking

There are some parking spaces for people with a disability at Boulevard de l'Empereur 4.

At the front, the Mont des Arts square is composed of stairs, but it has ramps in specific places. To reach the entrance of KBR by wheelchair, follow the route shown on the map.



## How to reach Rotterdam from KBR

### Train

KBR > Brussels-Central Station > Rotterdam

- Walk 5 minutes from KBR to Brussels-Central Station
- Take the direct train to Rotterdam SC (trip duration = about 2 hours)

KBR > Brussels Midi Station > Rotterdam

- Walk 5 minutes from KBR to Brussels-Central Station
- At Brussels-Central Station, take any train going to Brussels-Midi Station
- Take the high-speed train (Thalys) to Rotterdam (trip duration = about 1 hour)
